• Why Alpe d'Huez?

• Why come skiing at the end of the season?

Alpe d'Huez is one of the highest ski resorts in the Alps, which guarantees you very good snow conditions in March and even in April. At the same time it is warmer, less crowded and the prices are much lower than during French school holidays (February)

• What do we offer?

We offer packages **accommodation + skipass** (+ optionally transport from airport or railway station, ski rental, ski courses and/or alternative sport activities).
